## CHAPLAINCY ACCREDITATION?

Those authorised with Chaplaincy Australia need to have a passion for God and for people and a commitment to provide excellence in care.

**Chaplains** are required to have a current ACC credential, or if affiliated, from their own denomination, AND possess or complete the equivalent of a Cert IV in Pastoral Care or Cert IV in Ministry (Chaplaincy Major).

**Chaplaincy Team Members** need to have completed some basic courses relevant to their particular ministry area and are required to complete "Chaplaincy Essentials" as a stand alone training package or as part of the Cert IV in Ministry (Chaplaincy Major).

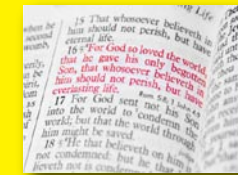
