The Certificate in Christian Ministries (Chaplaincy) has balanced content between theological development (biblical, theological and historical studies) and practical ministry development (chaplaincy and pastoral). The programme includes 150 hours of fieldwork experience.

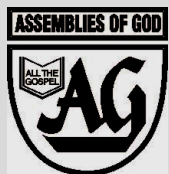

\$3,750 per year for NZ residents

Entry requirements:

Minimum 18 years of age with high school literacy and numeracy skills. Senior pastor's recommendation required.

Non-native English speaking or international students should have a minimum English ability equivalent to IELTS 5.5.

Units:

Chaplaincy units are taught as intensive courses in a classroom setting. Other courses are available by distance education on our e-learning platform. Students will need access to reliable internet facilities to complete this programme.

Students may apply for cross credit from the Alphacrucis Certificate in Christian Ministries.

Introduction to the Old Testament

This subject provides an overview of the history, themes and cultural background of the Old Testament.

Introduction to the New Testament

Through an analysis of the history and theology of the New Testament, students are trained to interpret and communicate its message, principles and values.

Christian Discipleship

Introducing contemporary Christian approaches to discipleship, this subject focuses particularly on the way in which Pentecostal/Charismatic movements have experienced God.

Christian Worldview

What is our worldview? This subject looks at the central elements of Christian faith, helping students to explore the beliefs that are core to Christianity.

Foundations of Chaplaincy

This prescription explores the role and functions of chaplains throughout history and how chaplaincy can be applied today.

Fieldwork 1 & 2 - Chaplaincy

Students will be required to commit 150 hours of ministry placement to develop foundation skills of chaplaincy practice and participate in supervised chaplaincy ministry.

Leadership - Chaplaincy

Students will learn how to apply leadership principles and handle complex client issues and crises.

Certificate in Christian Ministries (Chaplaincy)

The Certificate in Christian Ministries (Chaplaincy) is a specialised qualification aimed at training students to be chaplains who can provide a high standard of care to the community in their chosen chaplaincy field.

On completion of this course, students will be able to apply for ordination in a range of denominations and for accreditation as a chaplain. It will allow students to staircase into the Diploma in Chaplaincy and Diploma in Christian Ministries, and into degree programmes offered by other providers.
